This hop variety from Wye in Kent was bred with the goal of expanding the varietal range. In terms of the alpha acid content, it matures about one week earlier than average and has considerably better yields in terms of alpha acid per hectare than other hops in its class. Admiral is characterised by strong growth characteristics. Its small compact cones make harvesting easy. Admiral's tolerance to wilt is similar to the UK variety Progress and it has very good storage stability.
